## **Refunds**

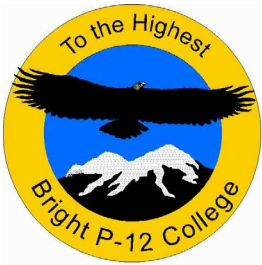
