- ➤ **Compass** a web based management system for parents and students to access learning tasks, homework, timetables, reports, and to communicate with teachers
- ➤ Mathletics a comprehensive Numeracy resource for VCAL students, which can also be accessed at home for revision, consolidation and extension of skills
- > Technology subjects incur material costs (payment is required prior to the commencement of the subject).
- Art provision of additional materials (above the standard curriculum) to ensure students have the opportunity to experience a diverse and exciting range of art medium
- ➤ **Edrolo -** an excellent resource, providing comprehensive and up-to-date online video tutorials linked to VCE course content covered in class. This program is an **essential** support for students as they can access support during and out of class. It provides trial exams, study note summaries, videos/booklets, assessable tasks and is outstanding for revision.

**Optional Payments:** Items, activities or services that are **optional** and offered **in addition to the standard curriculum.** Students may access these on a **user-pays** basis.
